

# MATT W. MOORE

## Biography

Nicknamed MWM for short, Matt W. Moore is a man of many tastes and talents. He's a painter, a muralist, a graphic designer and a French-culture enthusiast.

Born in 1980 in Boston, Massachusetts, and now based in Portland, Maine, Matt earned a BFA in Graphic Design & New Media at Maine College of Art. He also studied at Boston University, Savannah College of Art and Design, as well as Rhode Island School of Design.

Matt became world-famous for a digital-abstract style he calls Vectorfunk. Through this unique form of kinetic art, he creates an expressive visual language that explores colorful, tight geometric patterns and semiotics, which he contrasts with whimsy and fantasy.

Moore's work is regularly exhibited across a vast array of venues and media, from walls and sculptures to playground blacktops. And he has collaborated with a wide variety of brands, from Ray Ban to Nike to Coca-Cola.

Whether working in fine art or commercial applications, Matt finds that each medium sparks the other. And he believes that cross-pollinating between disciplines allows him to constantly refresh his perspective and produce unique work.
